

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION for THE UKC TRAIL RIDGE KENNEL CLUB SHOWS

ENTRY INFORMATION ELIGIBILITY

1. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC or have a Temporary Listing (TL) number to pre-entry or day-of-show entry. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned. NO TL NUMBERS AVAILABLE AT THESE SHOWS.

CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

1. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry.

2. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to UKC not later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show.

3. All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the Event Secretary not later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show.

SCHEDULING CONFLICTS FOR DOGS

1. Exhibitors are responsible for being available for judging at the scheduled time.

2. Every possible effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors who have dogs entered in different conformation rings, but judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are advised to pick up their armbands as early as possible and to notify stewards in all rings affected by a conflict so that judges may more easily work around any conflicts.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Junior Showmanship shall consist of the following classes:

1. Pee-Wee. 2 years and under 4 years of age.

2. Sub-Junior. 4 years and under 8 years of age.

3. Pre-Junior. 6 years and under 8 years of age.

4. Junior Classes. 8 years and under 13 years of age.

a. Novice Junior. This class is for any Junior member who has never earned a Best Junior Handler award or who has not earned three first place wins from the Novice Junior class.

b. Open Junior. This class is for any Junior member who has earned a Best Junior Handler award (over an Open Junior or Open Senior) from the Novice Junior class or who has earned three first place wins from the Novice Junior class.

5. Senior Classes. 13 years of age and under 19 years of age.

a. Novice Senior. This class is for any Senior member who has never earned a Best Junior Handler award or who has not earned three first place wins from the Novice Junior or Novice Senior class.

b. Open Senior. This class is for any Senior member who has earned a Best Junior Handler award (over an Open Junior or Open Senior) from the Junior class or Novice Senior Class, or who has earned three first place wins from the Novice Senior class.

6. Best Junior Handler. Best Junior Handler class shall consist of the first-place winner from the Novice Junior class, the Open Junior Class, the Novice Senior Class and the Open Senior Class.

CONFORMATION

1. Males judged before Females.

2. Points are awarded to the winners of the following classes offered for UKC recognized breeds that are eligible for conformation: Puppy, Junior, Adult, Open, Breeder/Handler, Best Male of Variety, Best Male, Best Female of Variety, Best Female, and Best of Winners.

NON-LICENSED CLASSES.

The following non-licensed classes are offered at these events. When non-licensed classes are offered, they must be run in accordance with the procedures outlined in the current Official UKC Rules and Regulations. **1.** *Novice Puppy, Veteran, Brace.* (All six shows): Novice Puppy, Veteran, & Brace will be judged immediately following Altered. Altered follows the regular classes. The Best of Breed Novice Puppy, Veteran & Brace will compete in Best In Show. Altered, Novice Puppy, Veteran & Brace Groups are not offered at these shows. **2.** *Group Competition*: The following Groups will be offered: Guardian, Scenthound, Sighthound & Pariah Dog, Gun Dog, Northern Breed, Herding Dog, Terrier, and Companion Dog. Each Group shall include the Best of Breed winners from those breeds assigned to that specific Group in the Official UKC Rules and Regulations.

3. *Best In Show*: A Best in Show class will be offered, consisting of the 8 winners of the regular Group classes. A single judge selected by the Event Committee will judge Best in Show.

4. Reserve Best In Show: After selecting the Best in Show winner, the judge shall select from the remaining dogs in the class a Reserve Best in Show winner.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the North & South on I-25: Take Exit 250. Go west on E State Hwy 56, to Berthoud (toward the mountains). Love's Travel Stop will be on your left. Travel approximately 5 miles. At the circle just before getting into Berthoud, take the 3rd exit onto 1st St. Turn left onto E Indiana Ave. There is plenty of parking on NE 2nd St, E Michigan Ave, and 3rd St. around the park. There is a small parking lot with limited parking space. NO RV's in this parking area. USE THE CIRCLE to get to the park. **Please do not move signs for Judge's, Staff, or Emergency Parking.**

FACILITIES

There is a building with indoor toilets in the park. PARKING is around the perimeter of park, NO PARKING allowed on the grass; violators will be ticketed. NO OVERNIGHT RV parking available onsite. NO SMOKING will be strictly enforced in all show areas and areas so designated. **TRKC Trailer is for Judges & Staff use ONLY.**

There is very limited shade throughout the park. It is suggested you bring your own shade or canopy. Also, bring your own water. NO dumpsters or trash cans at the site. **TAKE YOUR TRASH WITH YOU!**

ENTRY CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

1. Entry cancellations must be received in writing prior to the closing of preentries. Cancellation requests must be mailed or emailed to the Event Secretary. Requests must include the dogs UKC number, breed, name, and event type entered. Cancellations received by telephone will not be accepted.

2. Cancellations submitted before the close of entries will be charged \$5 per entered class.

3. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the preentry closing date and time.

4. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

5. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. However, if a duplicate entry is processed, no refund will be made.

6. Entry overpayments will be donated to the general trophy fund.

7. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host club, it is impossible to open or to complete an event, no refund of entry fees will be made.

8. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors, or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to, snowstorms, hurricanes, tornados, lightning, flooding, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop an event before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

These events are being hosted by the Trail Ridge Kennel Club and are United Kennel Club (UKC) licensed conformation shows. All UKC rules and regulations will apply. **BRING A COPY OF YOUR DOGS RABIES CERTIFICATE!**

Entries to all UKC events for both licensed and non-licensed classes must be submitted using the most current official UKC forms. Junior Showmanship has a NEW separate entry form.

Exhibitors through their submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the UKC rules and regulations.

The use of alcohol or illegal drugs at a UKC event is prohibited. Violators may be excused from the ring by the judge and from the show or event grounds by the Event Committee or any officer of the host club.

Dogs must be registered with the UKC to enter and have a permanent registration number, valid Temporary Listing (TL) or a Limited Privilege (LP) number as of the day of the event.

UKC exhibitors and spectators are expected to display good behavior and good sportsmanship in and out of the ring.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and maintaining a clean crating and/or grooming area.

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closure date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for dismissal.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$40 service charge on all returned checks.

Parents or guardians are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety.

Trail Ridge Kennel Club will not be responsible for loss or damage to any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result be accident or another cause.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, weather or other act beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this show, NO refund of entry fees will be made. NO substitutions are allowed.
